Overview of Perek Heh , Halacha 1-10:

Rabbinical Decrees Regarding Animals & Land:

Halacha 1: Methods that a בְּעַל הַשְּׂדֵה (*Ba'al Hasodeh*) may employ to prevent a בְּהֵמָה from damaging his property

Halacha 2: Prohibition of raising small animals and small beasts in Eretz Yisroel

Halacha 3: 10 conditions that Yehoshua established when the Eretz Yisroel was divided

1. Permission for a בְּהֵמָה דֹקָה (*Behaima Daka*) to graze in forests that are thick with trees
2. Permission to collect wood from another person's field, under three conditions.
3. Permission to collect grass that is growing on its own
4. Permission to cut off a branch from any tree
5. Permission for a city to make use of a spring whose source is somewhere else
6. Fishing restrictions in the Kineret Sea
7. Lavatory rights in private property
8. Permission to take shortcuts in vineyards when people are lot
9. Permission to walk on private property when the roads are filled with mud
10. A מֵת מִצְוָה (*Meis Mitzvah*) acquires its place and should be buried there

Halacha 4: Enactment of שְׁלֹמֹה (*Shlomo*) permitting trespassing in private paths in the fields during the summer

Halacha 5: Decrees are always applicable even outside of אֶרֶץ יִשְׂרָאֵל (*Eretz Yisroel*)

Halacha 6: Trespassing in Bavel is prohibited when the dew descends

Halacha 7: Permission to raise בְּהֵמָה דֹקָה (*Behaima Daka*) before holidays and weddings; permission for butchers

Halacha 8: בָּבֶל (*Bavel*) has the same status as אֶרֶץ יִשְׂרָאֵל (*Eretz Yisroel*) regarding raising בְּהֵמָה דֹקָה (*Behaima Daka*)

Halacha 9: Prohibition of raising pigs and dogs

Halacha 10: A רוּעָה (*Ro'eh*) who wants to do תְּשׁוּבָה (*Teshuva*)
