15. Mr. Mazik's cow [which is worth 20 זוז] is walking in a רְשׁוּת הַרְבִּימִים (Reshus Harabim). It sits [for the first time ever] on a **small** glass jar worth 50 זוז and breaks it. What is the law? Why?
16. Mr. Mazik's domesticated pet wolf [which is worth 100 זוז] attacks and kills [for the first time ever] Mr. Nizak's lamb, which was in a רְשׁוּת הַרְבִּימִים, that was worth 200 זוז. The corpse is worth 20 זוז. What is the law? Why?
17. Mr. Mazik's donkey is pulling a wagon in Mr. Nizak's field. During the course of its movement, the wagon runs over a glass bottle worth 50 זוז. A piece of the glass bottle flies out and breaks another glass bottle worth 50 זוז. What is the law? Why?
18. Mr. Mazik's cow [which is worth 100 זוז] swishes its tail in an abnormal manner while in a רְשׁוּת הַרְבִּימִים and breaks a glass worth 100 זוז. Mr. Mazik comes to the court and admits what his animal has done. What is the law? Why? [Give a complete answer]
19. During the times of the First Temple era, Mr. Mazik's cow [which is worth 100 זוז] kicks the ground while in a רְשׁוּת הַרְבִּימִים, propelling stones that breaks a glass worth 100 זוז, which is in Mr. Nizak's field. What is the law? Why?
20. During the times of the First Temple era, Mr. Mazik's chicken sticks his head in an empty glass bottle worth 100 זוז. The chicken crows and its sound waves break the glass. Mr. Mazik runs to the Beis Din and confesses to the story. What is the law? Why?
